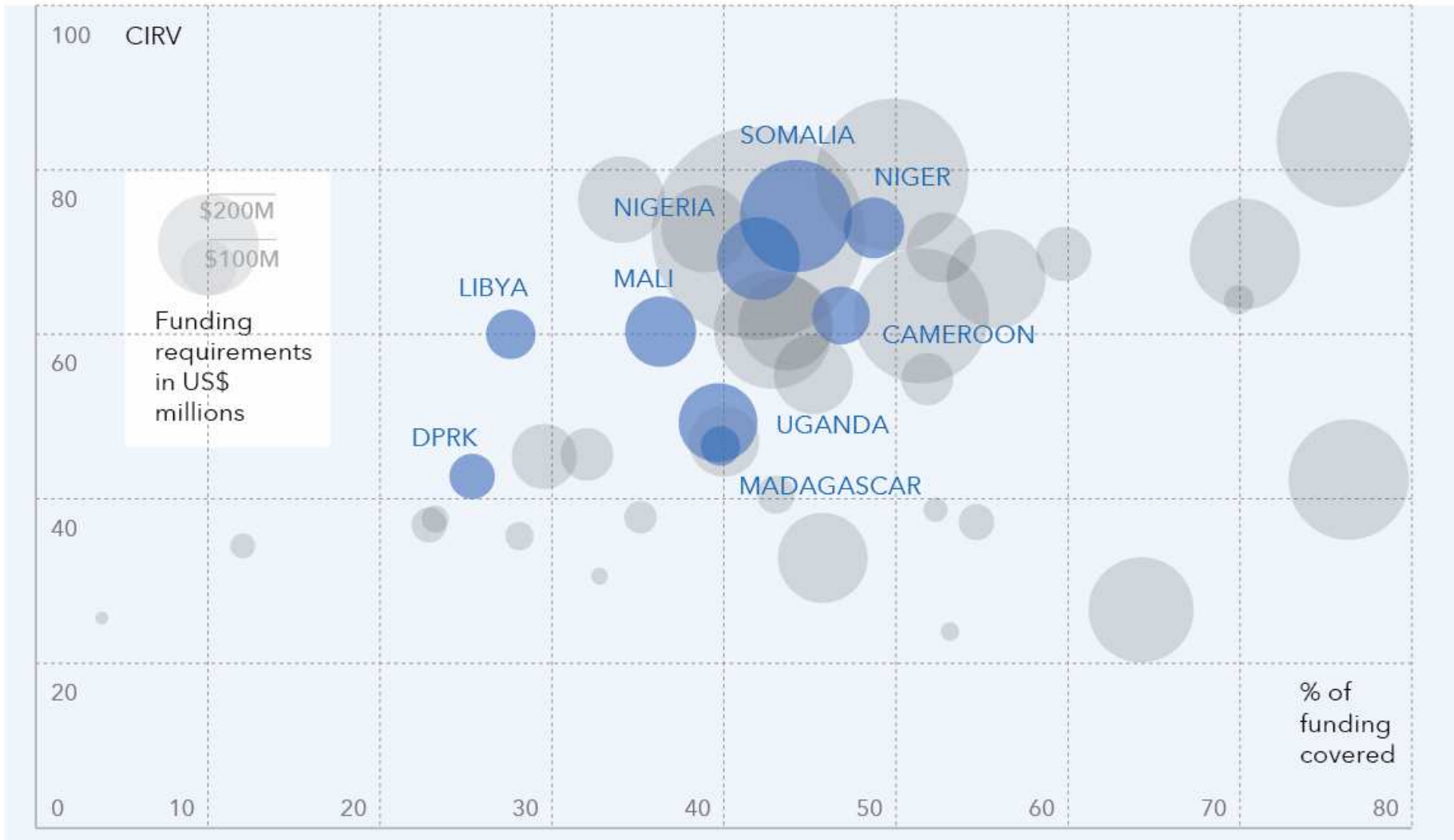

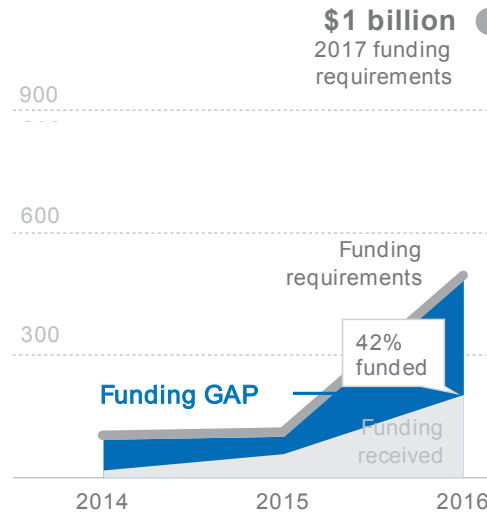

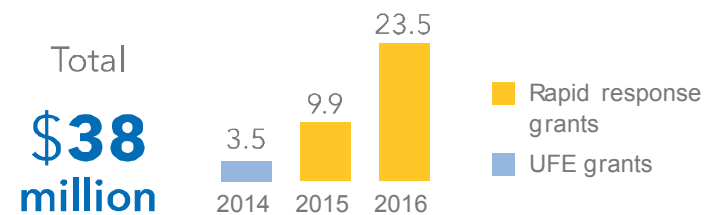

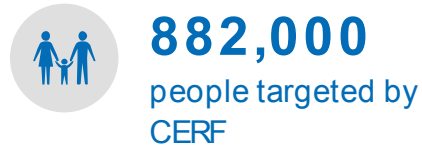

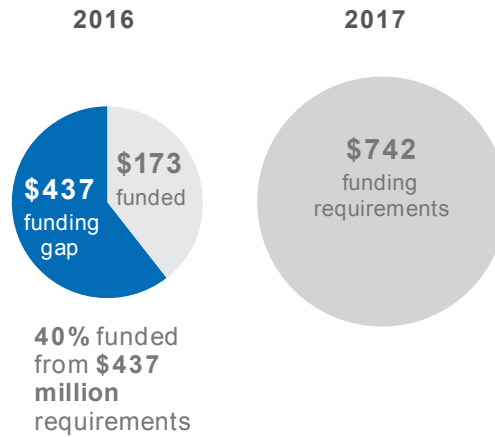
CERF funding to Somalia by year (in US\$ million)



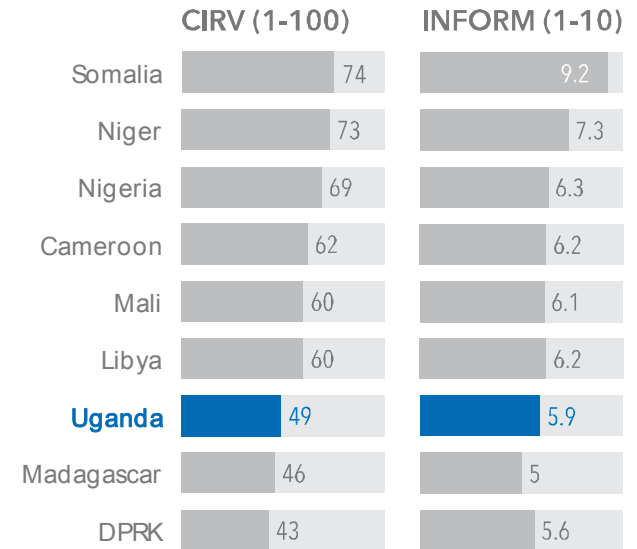

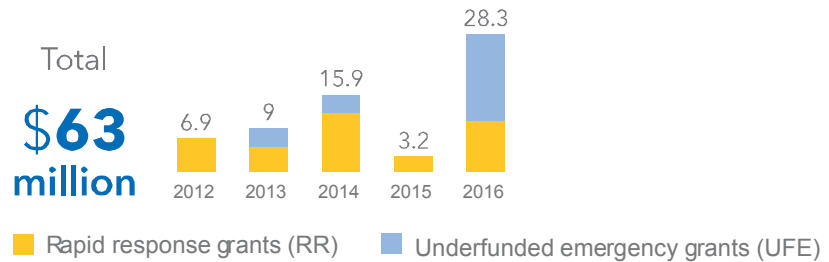

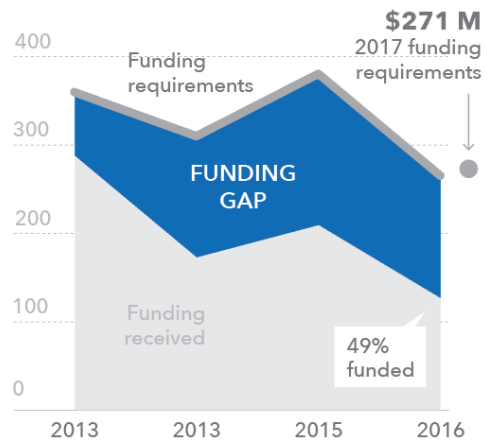

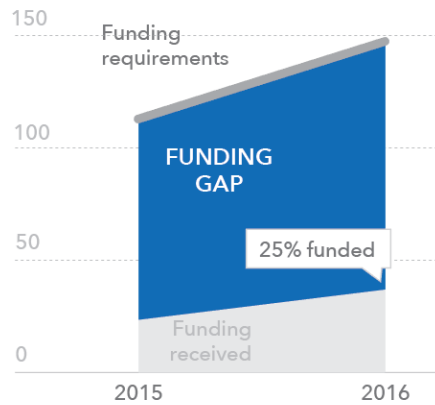

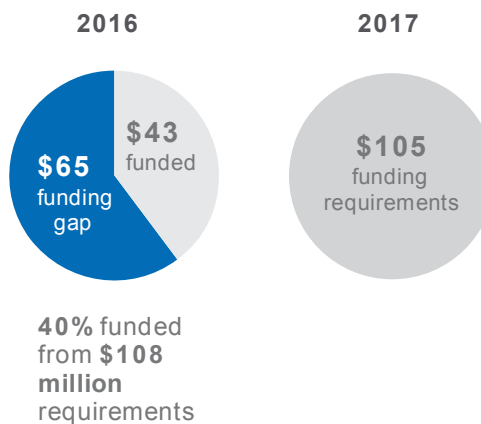
