## » DONATING THROUGH THE SYRIA EMERGENCY RESPONSE FUND (ERF)

Because many aid organizations (UN and NGOs) are operating under the SHARP and RRP, some donors prefer to give to a pooled fund that channels contributions to these organizations according to the priority humanitarian needs on the ground. The Fund responds quickly and fills gaps in priority sectors and geographical areas through a consultative and collaborative approval processes at the country level. [Non-governmental organizations \(NGOs\) are eligible to apply for the fund directly.](#) In 2013, the ERF disbursed over US\$32.6 million to reach beneficiaries inside Syria and in neighbouring countries.
