VIRTUAL LAUNCH OF THE GLOBAL HUMANITARIAN OVERVIEW 2021

On 1 December 2020, the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) and the United Kingdom Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) will co-host a virtual launch of the 2021 Global Humanitarian Overview (GHO) in London.

The GHO is the world's most comprehensive, authoritative and evidence-based overview of the current state and future trends in humanitarian action. It is published by OCHA.

This event will take place as part of a global initiative to:

- Engage decision-makers and humanitarian actors in highlighting the key themes covered in the 2021 GHO;
