

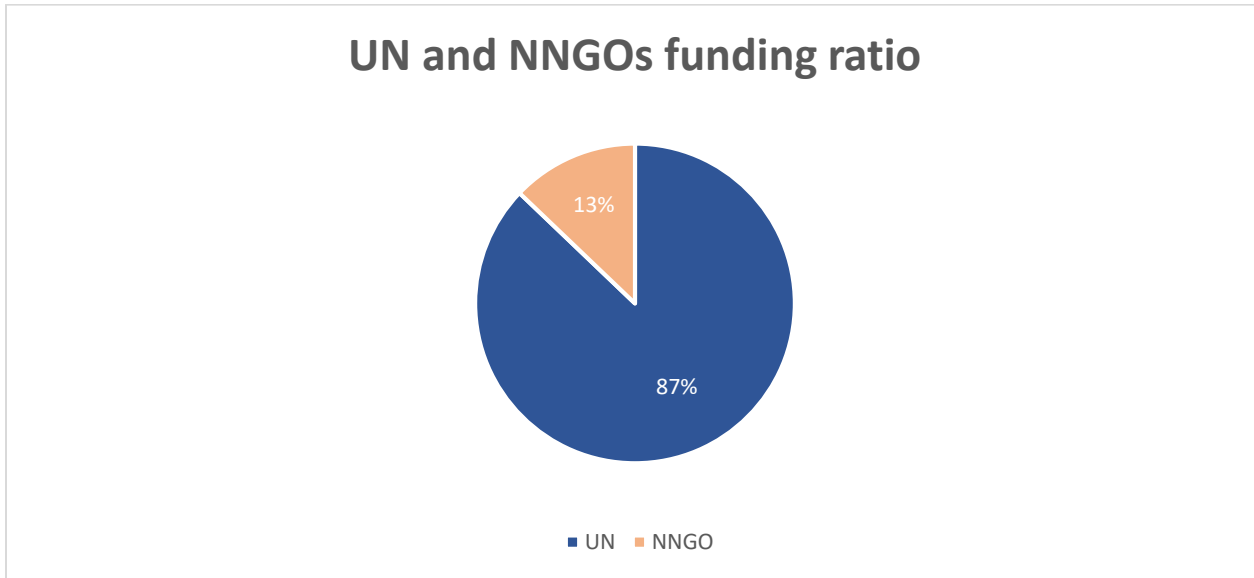
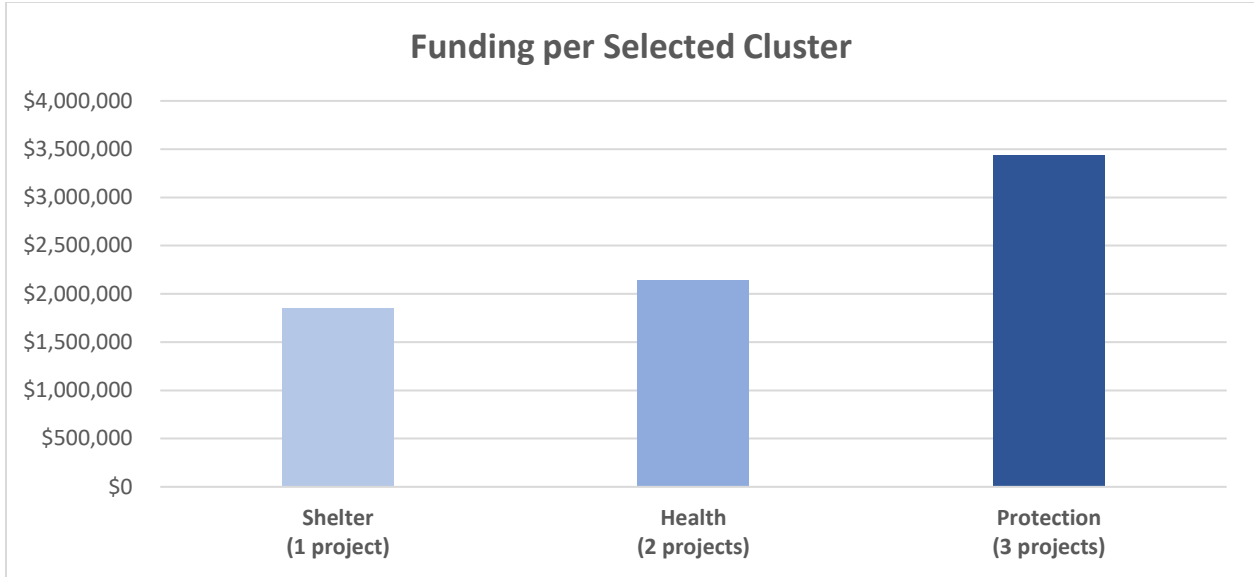
# Yemen Humanitarian Fund (YHF)

Projects Proposed for Funding under the  
Second Reserve Allocation 2018

1. **Scope:** The second Reserve Allocation (RA) for the 2018 YHF was launched on 24 July with the objective of supporting the emergency response in Al Hudaydah. The following priority gaps have been identified: a) emergency transportation allowance for displaced persons; b) civil documentation and cash assistance for people at very high risk; c) site management and coordination; d) emergency reproductive health services; and e) mine action. The deadline to submit proposals was on 27 July.
2. **Review of Proposals:** OCHA's Humanitarian Financing Unit, with support from Cluster Coordinators, organised Strategic and Technical Review Committee (STRC) meetings on 29 July ahead of the YHF Advisory Board meeting on 1 August. The STRC used a score card to determine the strategic, programmatic and financial relevance of the submitted proposals.
3. **Indicators:** STRCs reviewed proposals using the following indicators: a) the project adheres to the conditions set out in the RA strategy; b) a full project proposal has been submitted in the online Grants-Management System (GMS); c) the project has been submitted before the deadline; d) the partner has the technical capacity for implementing the different component of the project; and e) the partner has consulted national or sub-national clusters. STRCs ranked proposals taking into account: a) project scores; b) the number of projects; c) amount requested; and d) Country-based Pooled Fund budget criteria.
4. **Proposed Projects:** Eleven projects were screened by the STRCs. Five were excluded for being outside the scope of the strategy or due to lack of prior consultation with the Clusters. Six have been approved.
5. **Budget:** The overall budget of the six selected projects is USD 7,428,229. The chart summarizes the submissions.
