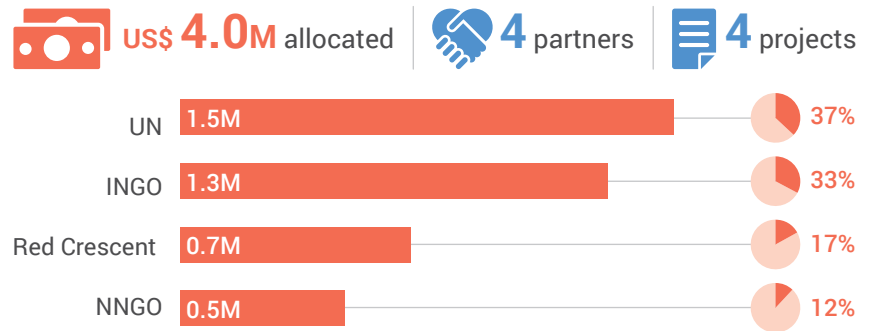
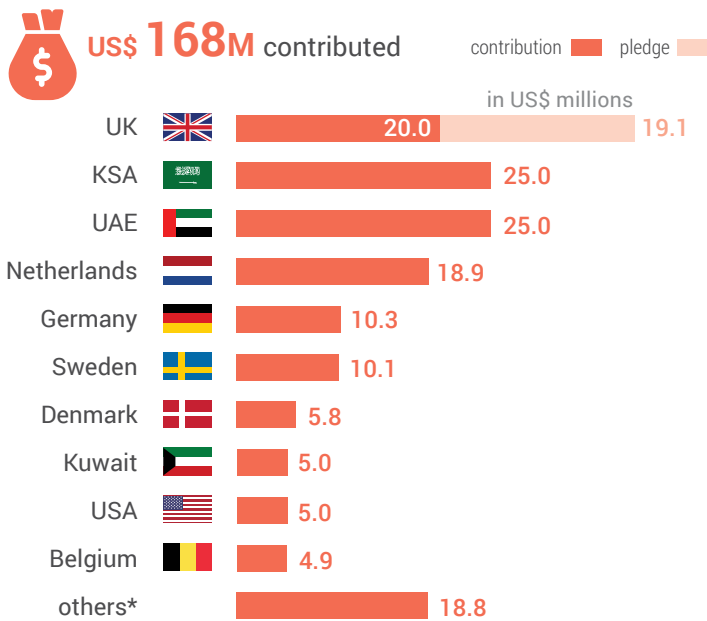


The 3rd Reserve Allocation of the Yemen Humanitarian Fund in 2018 was launched on 8 November with the aim of supporting winterisation assistance for people affected by the Hudaydah crisis. This Reserve Allocation is a single activity allocation targeting 15,000 IDP families originating from Al Hudaydah, with each family receiving USD 230. **Four projects amounting to almost USD 4M will cover nine governorates and reach 105,700 people.** They are being implemented by one UN agency, one national NGO, one international NGO and one Red Crescent organisation.

CONTRIBUTIONS BY DONORS (as of 24 November 2018)

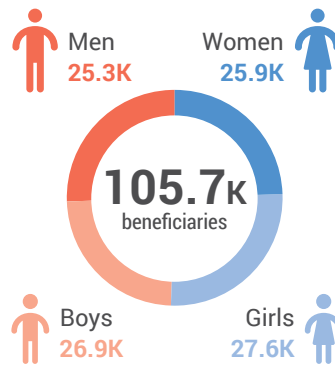
